Thank You for showing us the boundaries that were meant to be respected


Thank You for calling us to Prashanti Nilayam, and for the "carshan" gift

The design of the magazine has been improved.



- ➤ Human values based activities with children in Kwiejce is an on-going weekend project, mainly coordinated by the youth in Poland. Volunteers lead value-based activities for children (games, art, music, dramas etc.). In January 2014 the team of 9 volunteers prepared together with children Christmas songs and a drama which were shown to the parents.
- ➤ The youth engaged in the preparations for Polish National Sai Meeting that took place in May 2014 (translating, leading spiritual quiz).
